Mutual Recognition Application

Thank you for Antoun Civil Engineering (Aust) Pty Ltd's application for Mutual Recognition with Queensland's Department of Transport and Main Roads (TMR) under the Austroads' National Prequalification System for Civil (Road & Bridge) Construction Contracts (NPS).

TMR mutually recognises the full National Prequalification Levels granted to Antoun Civil Engineering (Aust) Pty Ltd (ABN 43 069 443 769) by RMS NSW of:

Please note that the awarding of a prequalification status is not a guarantee of work.

Your prequalification with TMR will automatically expire on 18 April 2022.

There are some specific additional requirements that apply to contracts for TMR and these are provided as an attachment. If you do not comply with these at the time of tender, your tender will not be accepted.

If Antoun Civil Engineering (Aust) Pty Ltd are considered "best" tender for a contract, you will be required to complete and submit P Schedules (P1 to P7/8) to enable an assessment to be carried out on the company's capacity to undertake the contract. This includes the financial, key personnel (including detailed CV's on TMR template), suppliers /contractors and technical aspects.

Where the Principal determines that the contents of these Schedules and any additional material supplied do not comply with the requirements of Transport Infrastructure Project Delivery System (TIPDS) or the tender documents or otherwise represent an unacceptable risk to the Principal, the tender will then be deemed to be nonconforming and will be rejected.

There is an expectation that the staff assigned to work on any project in Queensland will be employees of Antoun Civil Engineering (Aust) Pty Ltd.

I would like to remind you that the performance of the company will be monitored continually via monthly performance reports on all TMR projects. Please refer to Section 8 of the TIPDS Volume 3 Part A and in particular Section 8.3 which outlines your requirements and obligations with regards to performance reports. Failure to have satisfactory performance on any TMR project can result in the withdrawal of your mutual recognition.

You are required to promptly advise this office of any change in your prequalification level in NSW.

I look forward to the contribution from Antoun Civil Engineering (Aust) Pty Ltd on the delivery of Transport and Main Roads' infrastructure programs.
